LEEMING BAR



DL7 9AR

Recently restored, this Grade II listed building is now set in the 1920s, serving as both a working station and the Station Master's living quarters.

It is also the headquarters of our railway, with offices and the locomotive stock workshop.



LEYBURN

Leyburn is the main market town of mid-Wensleydale (1/4 mile walk from the Station) with cafés and shops. Market day is on Friday.

Take a walk along the Shawl, a limestone escarpment with fantastic views. Reputedly named because Mary, Queen of Scots lost her shawl whilst escaping from Bolton Castle!

Bedale Station is located in a small Georgian market town with a good range of shops and attractions, including a museum and a Tuesday market.

The Station includes a tea room and bookshop.

This well-preserved example of a small rural station featured in the original "All Creatures Great & Small" television series, and is themed as a wartime 1940's station.
